



## Authorization for Non-Prescription Over the Counter Medications

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The following: **sunscreen, moisturizing skin lotion, lip balm, insect repellent, sanitizer and diaper cream** can have a single parental authorization (written approval) and can be administered without a medication consent form as long as they are non-prescription (over-the-counter). YMCA staff require the product to be in its original packaging or we will not be able to apply to your child. Please note, YMCA Educators will not track and document the administration of the following items.

I give permission for YMCA Child Care staff to administer the following products as per the packaging directions. *Please note all items must be in their original container for a YMCA staff to administer.*

- All parents must provide written consent in order for YMCA staff to administer non-prescribed creams or bug sprays; otherwise, we are unable to do so.
- The YMCA will only administer non-prescription, over the counter medications and creams in their original packaging.
- The product must be provided by the parent/guardian.
