At this time, we have been advised by the Rainbow District School Board that schools will remain open, and we will have access to our licensed full day child care (infant, toddler, preschool).

However, we have been advised by Rainbow District School Board that in-person classes are cancelled Friday Nov. 4<sup>th</sup>, 2022. and we are not able to operate our before and after school programs as scheduled.
